



### **Foundation**

Foundation have been learning about Megan Coyle, a magazine collage artist. Therefore, they have been making colourful art by getting vibrant torn paper and sticking it to plain paper.

### Year 1

Year 1 have been learning about Ilya Bolotowsky, a geometric artist. Therefore, they have made art with shapes.

### Year 2

Year 2 have been learning about Georges Seurat, a pointillism artist. Therefore, they have made art with lots of little dots to make a bigger picture.

### Year 3

Year 3 have been learning about Renata Bernal, another geometric artist. Therefore, they have made art with shapes.

### Year 4

Year 4 have been learning about El Anatsui, a recycled material artist. Therefore, they have made art by weaving and sticking old materials together.

### Year 5

Year 5 have been learning Friedensreich Hundertwasser (don't even attempt to pronounce it), who is a surrealist artist. Therefore, they have made art with simple shapes and straight lines.

### Year 6

Year 6 have been learning about Dan Fenelon, an artist who does drawings inside of drawings. Therefore, they have drawn animals and sectioned them apart to draw shapes inside each section.

### The School Dot Display

The school dot display has everyone's personal art dot on it. Each dot has the style of their artist. However, they replicated their style again to put on a dot to go on this display, which has replaced "The Sky Is the Limit" display. There is also a guide to each year group's dots and what they have been doing during Art Week. The display is based on the book described earlier, "The Dot." It shows Vashti painting with a paintbrush on a stick, getting thinner as it gets closer to the paintbrush. Similar to the "The Sky Is the Limit" board, it has a title; "Everything Starts With A Dot..."

Teaching children things they will know and learn for the rest of their lives.


What leisure activities have you recently taken up? Pilates and exercising more.


The book is written for children aged 4-7. The morale of the story is just because we are different, it does not mean we can't be together, play with each other and be friends with one another.



First draw a slight curve




Then draw facial features.

### **EYFS**




In Foundation, they have been learning about space! They are reading Aliens Love Underpants, a book about space and aliens who wear underpants.

### Year 2


In Year two, they have been learning about the amazing topic of The Great Fire of London. They are learning how Thomas Fariner

### Year 4


In Year 4 they have been learning about York and have been perparing for their residential. They have done the differences between

This term, Year 6 have been learning about the circulatory system as well as dissecting a sheep's heart. In English, they wrote from the perspective of a red blood cell.


