Dear Parents/Carers,

I wish to make you aware of a development that is connected with school. A parent of children in the school has tested positive for Covid-19 today and their children, in Yr 3 and 4 bubbles, are self-isolating.

We have been in communication with the Public Health Department for Nottinghamshire and have also referred to the national guidance which is clear. Bubbles of children should only be closed if a pupil or a member of staff has tested positive and, as such, school will be **open as usual** tomorrow.

Given that this is the closest known case that we have been aware of, we considered it fair and transparent to share this information with you. However, **from this point forward we will not be informing parents every time a parent tests positive**, only if a pupil or staff member tests positive. It could well be that, with an increase in cases, we would not be able to keep up with that flow of information. We will however, always inform the whole school if we have a confirmed case in school and have to close a bubble.

We look forward to seeing you in school tomorrow and reiterate the importance of social distancing and washing hands.
