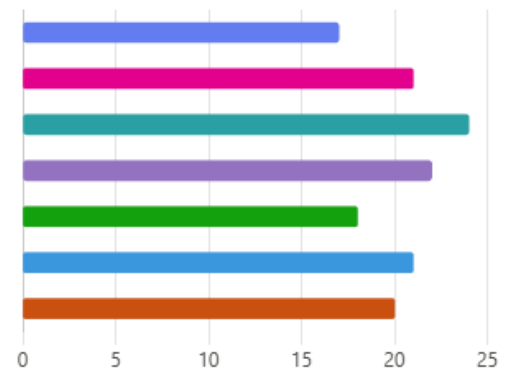

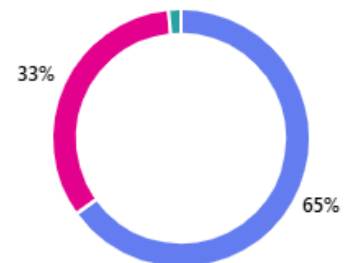

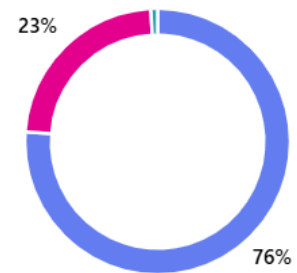
3. My child feels happy at school

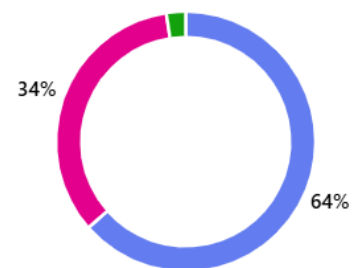
4. My child feels safe at school

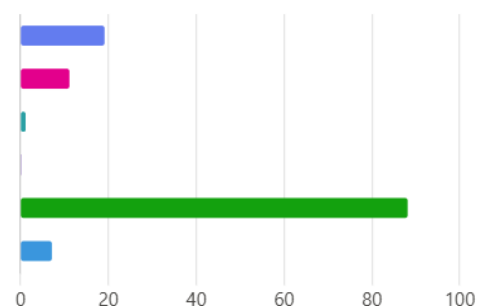
5. The school makes sure that children are well-behaved

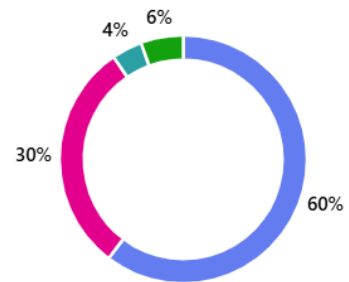
6. My child has special educational needs and the school gives them the support they need

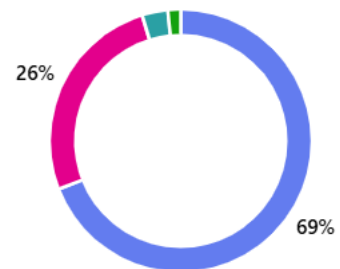
7. The school has high expectations of my child

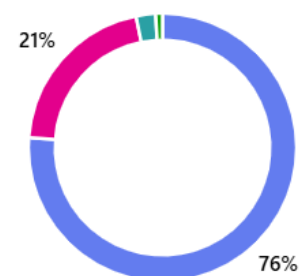
8. The school has a good range of opportunities for my child
